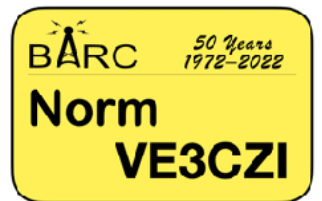
The Burlington Amateur Radio Club

The Burlington Amateur Radio Club was formed in the fall of 1972 on an initiative by Roy Higgins, VE3GBZ (SK). Over the years it has become the centre of organized Amateur Radio activity in Burlington. The Club operates four repeaters, regular classes for new hams, the CJ Flea Market in February and the Ontario Hamfest in July.

One of the Club's Charter Members was Noel Eaton, VE3CJ. In 1974 Noel was elected as ARRL Vice President and was also nominated to serve as the first President of the International Amateur Radio Union from outside of the United States. He was IARU President Emeritus when he became a silent key September 28, 1996.

Pins and Name Badges

To get your commemorative, complimentary pin and name badge your 2022-2023 membership must be paid for by July 31, 2022.
